



SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Introduction

School Uniform

GIRLS

- White polo top with or without school badge
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Grey trousers or shorts
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan displaying the school badge
- Grey tights or plain grey or white socks
- In the summer a blue and white check or striped dress can also be worn
- Plain black shoes or dark trainers
- Hair accessories, if worn, must be discreet and royal blue, white or blue and white gingham.
- Long hair must be tied back. This is to help avoid the spread of headlice.

BOYS

- White polo top with or without school badge
- Grey trousers or shorts
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan displaying the school badge
- Grey or white socks
- Plain black shoes or dark trainers
- Hair accessories, if worn, must be discreet and royal blue, white or blue and white gingham
- Long hair must be tied back. This is to help avoid the spread of headlice.

PE – Please note: PE kits to be worn to school on PE days.

- Sky blue polo-top with or without school badge
- Royal blue shorts or jogging bottoms
- Trainers

Optional items:

- Oaklands school book bag
- Oaklands school rucksack
- Reversible fleece lined jacket with school badge

Outdoor Play and Learning (OPAL): All children are required to bring in wellies or waterproof shoes, which can be kept at school, in order to access the school grounds during wet weather. We also encourage parents to send in a spare pair of socks, which can be kept in bookbags. Waterproof overtrousers or all-in-ones are also permitted. During the winter months children will need a warm waterproof coat. Hats, scarves and gloves are optional.

ALL ITEMS, INCLUDING FOOTWEAR AND BAGS, MUST BE NAMED.

Please note that the following items are not allowed to be worn in school:

- Leggings
- Ear rings (one ear stud per ear is acceptable)
- Rings
- Necklaces
- Bracelets
- Nail varnish
- Make-up
- Hair products – no colours
- Visible transfers or henna tattoos
