



SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Effective from September 2026 – royal blue joggers, shorts and white polo shirts can be worn until children outgrow them or they need to be replaced.

Introduction

Oaklands School recognise that the school uniform is an integral part of our identity and as such, our Uniform Policy provides clear guidance as to what to wear.

Our aim is to keep the requirements as simple and as practical as possible, taking into consideration our status as an Outdoor Play and Learning School. Our school providers are My Clothing (online) and Smartys in Stevenage, Hatfield and Potters Bar. Contact details can be found at the bottom of this policy.

1. School Uniform

GIRLS

- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan displaying the school badge
- Sky blue polo top with or without school badge
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress with either grey tights or plain white or grey socks.
- In the summer a blue and white check or striped dress can also be worn
- Plain black joggers or shorts can be worn if preferred to dresses or skirts.
- Long hair must be tied back.
- Dark trainers
- Traditional school shoes can be worn if preferred

BOYS

- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan displaying the school badge
- Sky blue polo top with or without school badge
- Plain black joggers or shorts
- Grey trousers or shorts can be worn if preferred
- Grey or white socks
- Long hair must be tied back.
- Dark trainers
- Traditional school shoes can be worn if preferred

PE (for boys and girls)

- Sky blue polo-top with or without school badge
- Plain black joggers or shorts

- Trainers for outdoor PE (children will be barefoot for indoor PE)

Optional items:

- Oaklands school book bag (Reception – Y2)
- Oaklands school rucksack (Y3-Y6)
- Reversible fleecy lined jacket with school badge

Jewellery: Earrings must be studs. No other jewellery is permitted. If there are religious or cultural reasons which require the wearing of items of jewellery other than studs, please contact the school office to let us know.

Make up: No make up

Outdoor Play and Learning (OPAL): All children are required to bring in wellies or waterproof shoes, which can be kept at school, to access the school grounds during wet weather. We also encourage parents to send in a spare pair of socks which can be kept in bookbags/school bags. Waterproof over trousers or all-in-one puddle suits are also permitted. During the winter months children will need a warm waterproof coat. Hats, scarves and gloves are encouraged.
